# Durango HOA – Bylaw Addendum Effective Date: April 5, 2025

This document serves as an official addition to the governing bylaws of the Durango Homeowners Association (HOA) in Loveland, Colorado. The following articles are added to **Article VII: Property Appearance and Use Regulations** and are to be treated as official governing rules.

# Article VII, Section 15: Political Signage

## **Display Duration:**

Political signs may be displayed no earlier than **100 days prior** to an election and must be removed within **5 days after** the election concludes.

## Compliance:

All signage must comply with **City of Loveland municipal codes and guidelines** regarding political signage.

## Quantity:

Each property is permitted to display a maximum of ten (10) political signs.

### Maintenance:

Homeowners are responsible for the upkeep of their signage, ensuring signs remain in good condition, are securely fastened, and do not present a safety hazard to drivers or pedestrians.

# Article VII, Section 23: Flag Presentation on Homes

### Placement:

Flags may be displayed using either:

- Freestanding flagpoles Installation of any new freestanding flagpole must be submitted to and approved by the Architectural Review Committee prior to installation.
- Mounted flagpoles attached to homes These must be securely mounted, properly maintained, and visually appropriate.

# Expression:

The Durango HOA respects the right to freedom of speech. Concerns or complaints regarding displayed flags may be submitted in writing to the HOA Board for review. **Hate speech or hateful symbolism will not be tolerated.** 

## Quantity:

A maximum of **three (2) flags per property** is permitted. Flags visible from the street are subject to review and oversight by the HOA and Architectural Review Committee.

# Article VII, Section 24: Holiday Decorations

### **Removal Timeline:**

Holiday decorations must be taken down within **30 days after the associated holiday**.

## Spring Clean-Up Compliance:

Decor left up beyond this time, especially past the **Spring Clean-Up home inspections**, may result in notices and/or fines issued by the HOA.

### **Christmas Exception:**

**Christmas lights** may remain up from **October through February** as an exception to the standard timeline.

## Lighting Considerations:

The use of excessive graphics or outdoor lighting displays is discouraged and may be subject to removal if it creates a nuisance or safety concern for others.
